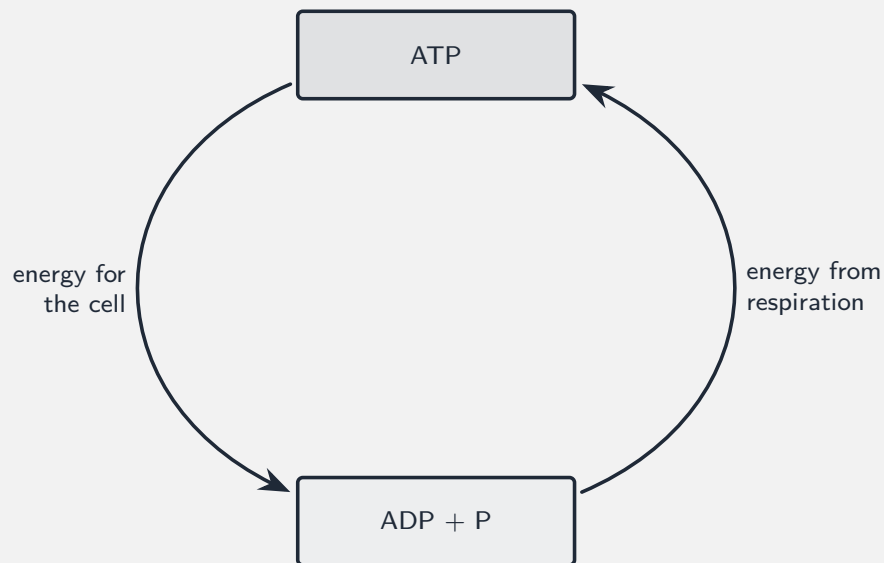
Recall

Every cell needs a steady supply of **energy** 能量. It gets this energy from **respiration** 呼吸作用—the breaking down of food molecules.

New ideas

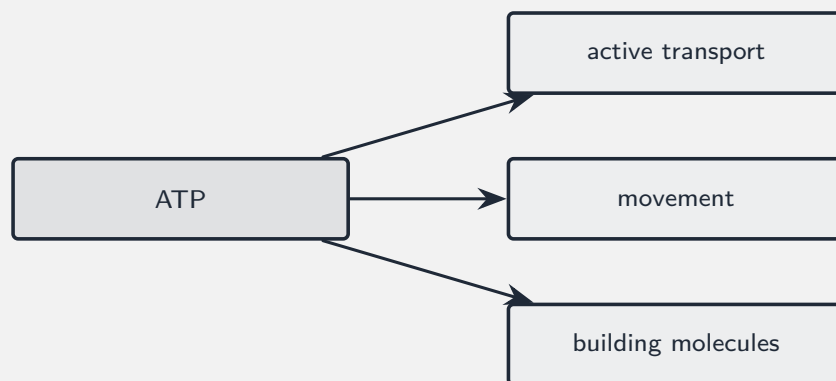
Read these first, then do the Practice.

■ 1 ATP, the energy currency



ATP is the molecule that carries energy. Respiration adds a phosphate to ADP to make ATP; when the cell needs energy, it breaks ATP back to ADP + phosphate, releasing a small, usable burst.

■ 2 What the energy is for



Cells spend ATP on **active transport** 主动运输 (moving substances against a gradient), movement (like muscle contraction), and building large molecules.

Watch out: ATP is the energy *currency* —it carries energy in small, usable bursts and is constantly recycled (made from ADP + phosphate, then broken back). It is *not* a long-term energy store.
