The body has two control systems. One is fast and electrical; the other is slower and chemical.

■ 1 Two systems

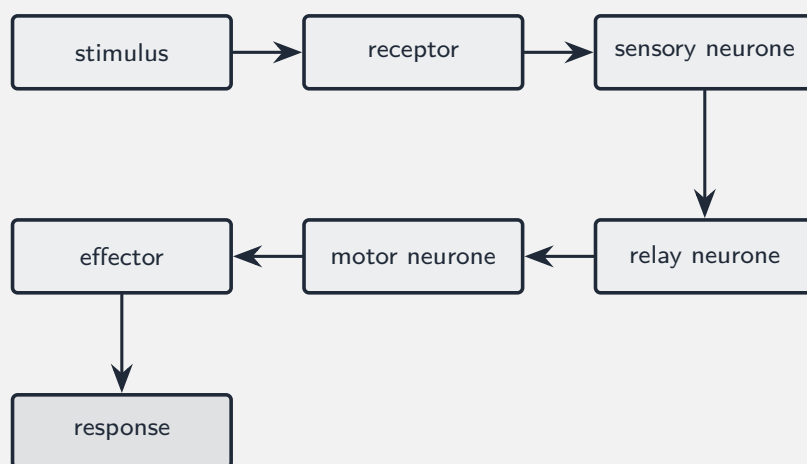
nervous system
electrical impulses
along nerves — fast, short

endocrine system
chemical hormones
in the blood — slow, lasting

- the **nervous system** 神经系统 sends fast electrical impulses along **neurones** 神经元 (nerve cells);

- the **endocrine system** 内分泌系统 sends slower chemical **hormones** 激素 in the blood.

■ 2 The reflex arc



A **reflex** is a fast automatic response. The **reflex arc** 反射弧 is the path it takes: stimulus → receptor → sensory neurone → relay → motor neurone → effector → response.

Watch out: the nervous system is *fast* and *electrical* (impulses along neurones, short-lived); the endocrine system is *slower* and *chemical* (hormones in the blood, longer-lasting). A reflex is automatic—it can act before the brain is involved.
