Complete Fig. 5.1 by naming structure **A** and tissue layer **B**.

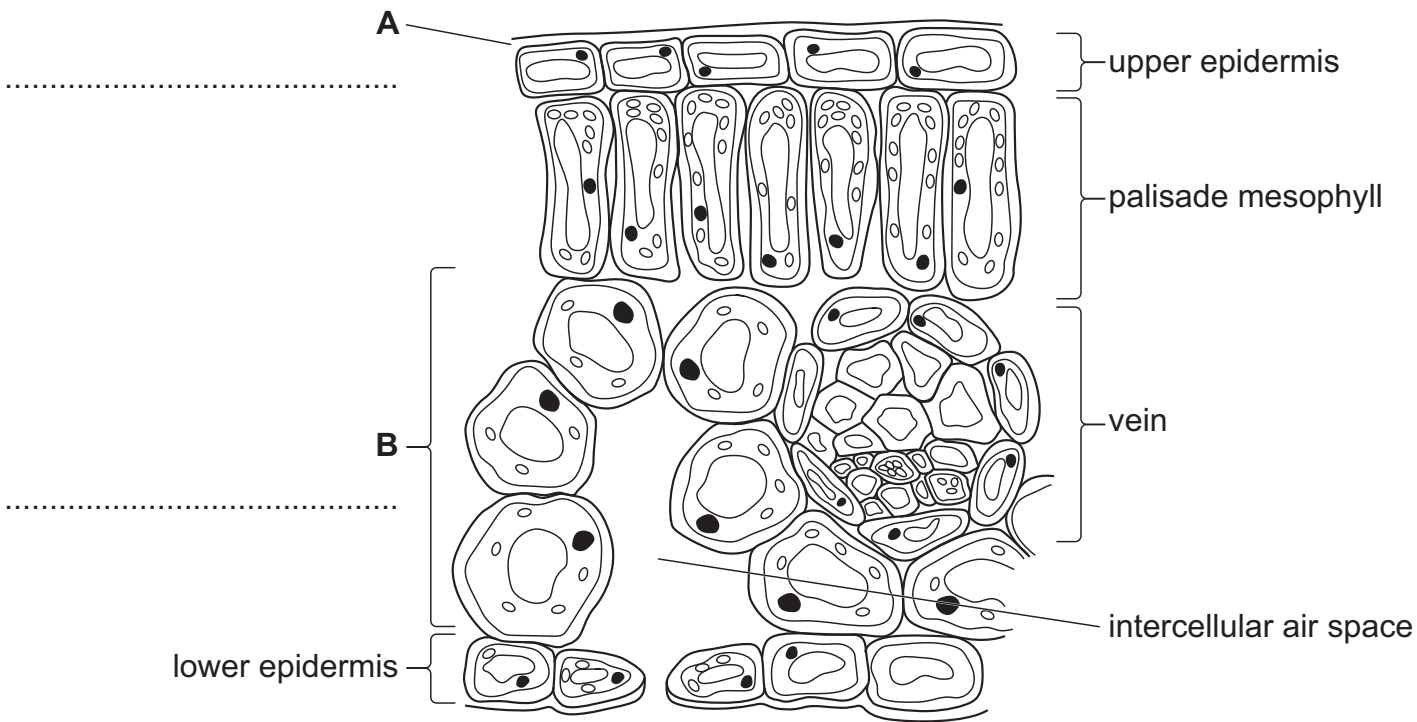
