Recall

A **transition element** 过渡元素 is a d-block element that forms at least one stable ion with an incomplete d sub-shell.

■ 1 Four key properties

variable oxidation states

act as catalysts

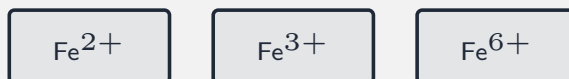
form complex ions

coloured compounds

Transition elements show variable **oxidation states** 氧化态, act as **catalysts** 催化剂, form complex ions, and make coloured compounds.

■ 2 Variable oxidation states

iron, for example:



3d and 4s are close in energy, so several states form

The 3d and 4s sub-shells are close in energy, so similar small amounts of energy remove different numbers of electrons —giving several oxidation states.

Watch out: a transition element forms at least one ion with an *incomplete* d sub-shell. That is why scandium (only Sc^{3+} , d^0) and zinc (only Zn^{2+} , d^{10}) are often *not* counted as typical transition metals.
