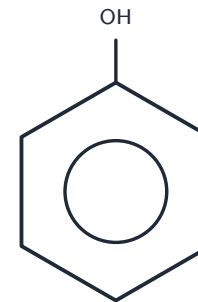
Recall

Phenol 苯酚 has an –OH group joined directly to a **benzene** 苯 ring. This changes its chemistry.

New ideas

Read these first, then do the Practice.

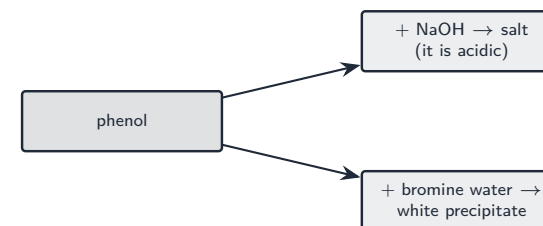
■ 1 Phenol's structure



phenol: OH joined to the ring

Because the –OH is on the ring, phenol is *more acidic* than an ordinary alcohol, and its ring is *more reactive*.

■ 2 Phenol's reactions



- with NaOH(aq): phenol reacts (an ordinary alcohol does not) — it is acidic;
- with bromine water at room temperature (no catalyst): a white precipitate of 2,4,6-tribromophenol.

Watch out: because the –OH sits *on* the ring, phenol is *more acidic* than an alcohol (it reacts with NaOH) *and* its ring is *more reactive* (it brominates with bromine water with no catalyst needed).
