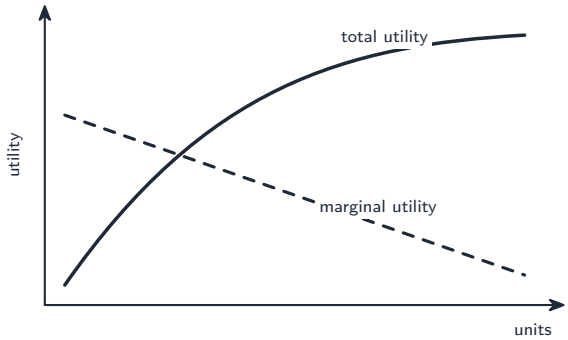
Recall

When you buy something, you get satisfaction from it. Economists call that satisfaction **utility** 效用.

New ideas

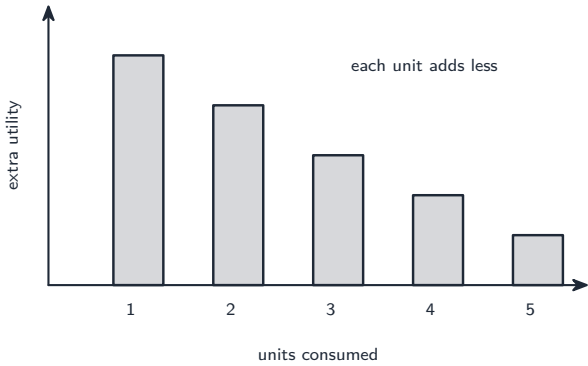
Read these first, then do the Practice.

■ 1 Total and marginal utility



- **total utility** 总效用 is the satisfaction from *all* the units you consume;
- **marginal utility** 边际效用 is the *extra* satisfaction from one more unit.

■ 2 Diminishing marginal utility



The law of **diminishing marginal utility** 边际效用递减 says each extra unit gives *less* extra satisfaction. (Your first slice of pizza is great; the fourth, less so.) Total utility still rises — just more slowly.

Watch out: total utility = satisfaction from *all* the units; marginal utility = the *extra* from one more. As you consume more, marginal utility *falls* but total utility still *rises* (just more slowly) — until marginal utility reaches zero.
