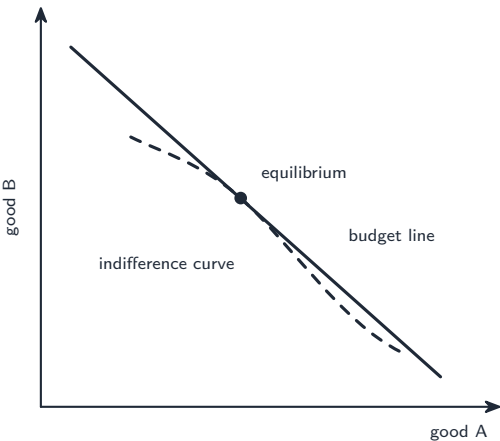

1 Consumer equilibrium



- an **indifference curve** 无差异曲线 shows combinations of two goods giving the *same* total utility;
- a **budget line** 预算线 shows what the consumer can just afford;
- **consumer equilibrium** 消费者均衡 is the best they can do — where the budget line just touches the highest reachable indifference curve.

2 Two kinds of efficiency

productive efficiency
making goods at the
lowest possible cost

allocative efficiency
making the goods
people most want

- **productive efficiency** 生产效率 — making goods at the lowest possible cost;
- **allocative efficiency** 配置效率 — making the goods people most want.

Watch out: consumer equilibrium is where the budget line just *touches* the highest reachable indifference curve. Productive efficiency = lowest *cost*; allocative efficiency = making what people most *want* — don't confuse the two.
