Each answer shows the steps, then the **result**.

2.1 B

- the raised surface carries ink in relief printing

2.2

- the inked block is pressed face-down onto the paper; this flips the image left-to-right

2.3

- a set of multiple near-identical prints made from one block/plate

3.1

- Look for: a bold high-contrast design suited to relief (1); cut/print areas clearly and correctly marked (2)

3.2

- Look for: the block version is correctly mirrored (2); the final print reads the right way round (1)
