■ The derivative

$$f'(x) = \lim_{h \rightarrow 0} \frac{f(x+h) - f(x)}{h}$$

is the instantaneous rate of change — the slope of the **tangent line** 切线. Notations:
 $f'(x)$, $\frac{dy}{dx}$, $\frac{d}{dx}[f(x)]$.
