Study these first. Each one shows the method for a question type used later.

■ The Mean Value Theorem

If f is continuous on $[a, b]$ and differentiable on (a, b) , there is a c in (a, b) with

$$f'(c) = \frac{f(b) - f(a)}{b - a}$$

— somewhere the tangent slope equals the average slope.

■ Example

$f(x) = x^2$ on $[0, 4]$: average slope $= \frac{16-0}{4} = 4$; $f'(c) = 2c = 4$ gives $c = 2$.
