eXercise

You must be able to

- build a body of ~15 images from one question
- show growth over time, not one afternoon repeated
- keep a make-document-reflect-revise rhythm
- choose depth over breadth

Method — Body of work

The SI is ~15 images growing from one inquiry — worth 60% of the score.

Method — Sustained = over time

Works must show growth, not 15 versions of one afternoon.

Method — Depth over breadth

One question pushed hard beats ten unrelated good drawings.
