2.1 B

- an open, personal, visual question you can develop through drawing

2.2

- a subject is a thing to draw / can only be illustrated; an inquiry is a question drawings can develop and partly answer over time

2.3

- list the works it could produce; fewer than about five means it is too narrow

3.1

- two genuine questions, not subjects; both open/personal/visual; five plausible works each; a note on which is stronger and why

3.2

- a real question, not a subject; open, personal, and drawable
