2.1 B

- **preponderance of evidence**, not all-or-nothing

2.2

- you cannot build toward a target you have not seen; early reading lets you self-score and fix gaps in time

2.3

- any two of: inquiry; practice/experimentation/revision; materials/processes/ideas; skills; synthesis

3.1

- every row scored with a reason; honest, evidence-based levels; the weakest row identified; a concrete action to raise it

3.2

- describes inseparable material/process/idea; specific to the student's own inquiry
