Work through these after you have tried the questions yourself.

2.1 a statement that requires support to be accepted.

2.2 whether someone could reasonably disagree; if not, it is a fact.

2.3 it bears on that particular claim - the same detail can be relevant to one claim and decorative to another.

2.4 the writer's explanation of how the evidence supports the claim.

2.5 the reader must supply the connection themselves, and may supply a different one from the writer's.

2.6 the missing element is the connection, and every additional piece of evidence needs its own connection too. \
