- the sequence of events in a narrative, connected, with each building on the others, often causally

- that events depend on one another, so a later event means what it means because of an earlier one

(a)

- the setting and action of the plot, and how the narrative develops to place characters in conflict

(b)

- the rising or falling fortunes of a main character or set of characters

3.1 A

- the CED's own phrase

3.2 A

- connection is what makes it a plot

- that the events are connected rather than consecutive

- the same incidents in a different order would mean something else, so the arrangement is part of what the text says
