2.1

- a comparison using “like” or “as” to liken two objects or concepts to each other

2.2

- it transfers the traits or qualities of one to the other; the main subject is the thing being compared and the comparison subject is the thing it is compared to

2.3

(a)

- which quality is transferred and what effect the transfer has on the reader

(b)

- “the comparison subject is X, whose quality of Y is transferred to the main subject Z”

3.1 B

- gravel is what the voice is compared to

3.2 A

- traits or qualities

3.3

(a)

- the city is the main subject and the furnace the comparison subject

(b)

- heat and containment transfer, so the city reads as something that consumes what it holds
