- creating anticipation; creating suspense; building tension

- anticipation is expecting something; suspense is expecting it without knowing when or how

2.3

(a)

- between what the reader knows and what they want to know

(b)

- “by beginning at X rather than Y, the text makes the reader read the intervening chapters looking for Z”

3.1 A

- building tension

3.2 A

- when or how

3.3

(a)

- suspense, and tension across the intervening chapters

(b)

- the reader is told something matters without being told why, and every intervening chapter is read against that unanswered question
