- a group or force can function as a character, acting, wanting and opposing as a character does

- the collective attitude of the group toward the character and possibly the character's attitude toward the group

2.3

(a)

- what the group will not tolerate; what the character will not give up

(b)

- that the second finding is less certain than the first

3.1 A

- as a character

3.2 A

- the character's attitude to the group

3.3

(a)

- what it will not tolerate, and that it acts collectively

(b)

- possibly what he has refused to give up, though the CED's "possibly" means this needs separate evidence from his own words or actions
