2.2 a comparison that persists through part or all of a text.

2.3 with additional details, similes and images.

2.4 assigning a human trait to a nonhuman object, entity or idea, characterising it; the analysis is in which trait is chosen.

2.5 what is happening in the text determines which quality is transferred, so the same comparison means differently elsewhere. \
