2.1

- any two of: justification by faith rather than works; the authority of scripture over tradition; the priesthood of all believers

2.2

- condemnation drew attention to the text, and copies already dispersed could not be recalled

(a)

- ecclesiastical authority and church property in his territory

(b)

- no — a political gain does not establish that the conviction was insincere

3.1 B

- faith rather than works performed through the church

3.2 B

- doctrine explains the content of the claim

3.3

(a)

- doctrine explains why the argument was made; politics explains why it prevailed where it did

(b)

- doctrine alone cannot explain the territorial pattern, and politics alone cannot explain the content
