2.1 it marked a break with existing Christian traditions; both reformations contributed to the growth of Christianity.

2.2 it gave authority over church appointments and lands, so the religious choice was also a political gain.

2.3 it moved the argument from clergy to ordinary readers within weeks, making it a public dispute.

2.4 each side had to hold and win people, so both invested in preaching, printing and schooling.

2.5 the CED records both reformations increasing Christianity's reach rather than reducing it. \
