2.1 stability - containing the danger of upheaval by agreement among the powers.

2.2 borders were drawn to balance the powers against each other, so peoples could be placed under states they had not chosen.

2.3 that institutions grown over time carry knowledge no designer possesses.

2.4 it makes a claim about how knowledge accumulates, which must be answered with an argument rather than dismissed as interest.

2.5 that it prevented a general European war for decades; that it did so by ignoring national claims. \
