- a boundary forced onto an area by an outside power, ignoring the existing cultural pattern

- delimited = drawn on a map; demarcated = physically marked on the ground with fences/signs

- relict boundary

- geometric boundary

3.1 B

- drawn before settlement = antecedent boundary

3.2 C

- physically marking it on the ground is demarcation

- superimposed (and geometric)
