

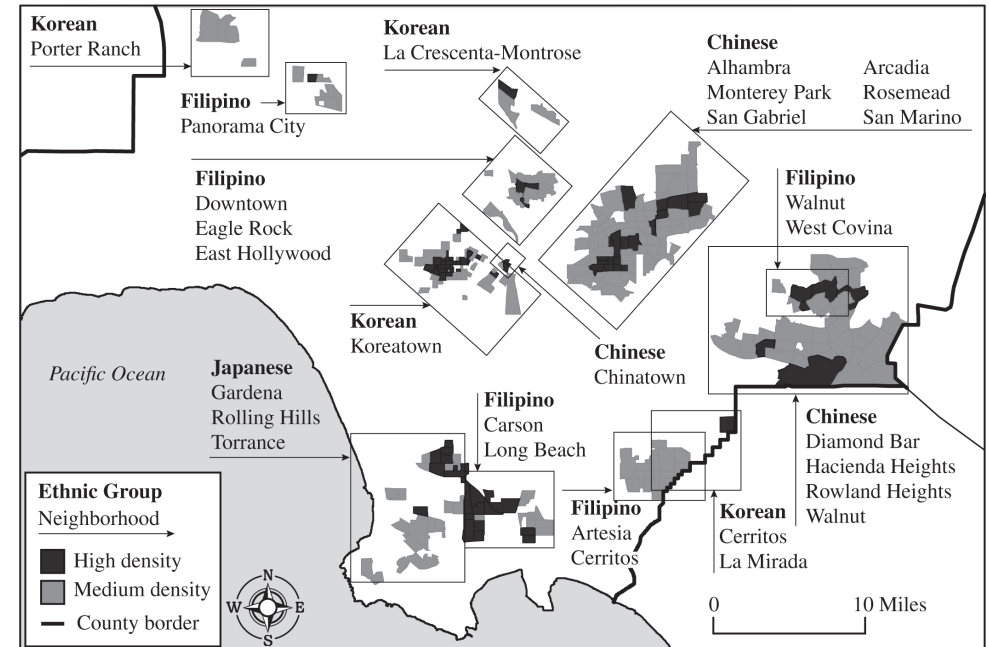
1. Migration contributes to significant population growth and change in urban landscapes. As populations increase, urban areas face economic, social, and environmental challenges.

Selected Asian Ethnic Neighborhoods in Los Angeles County, California



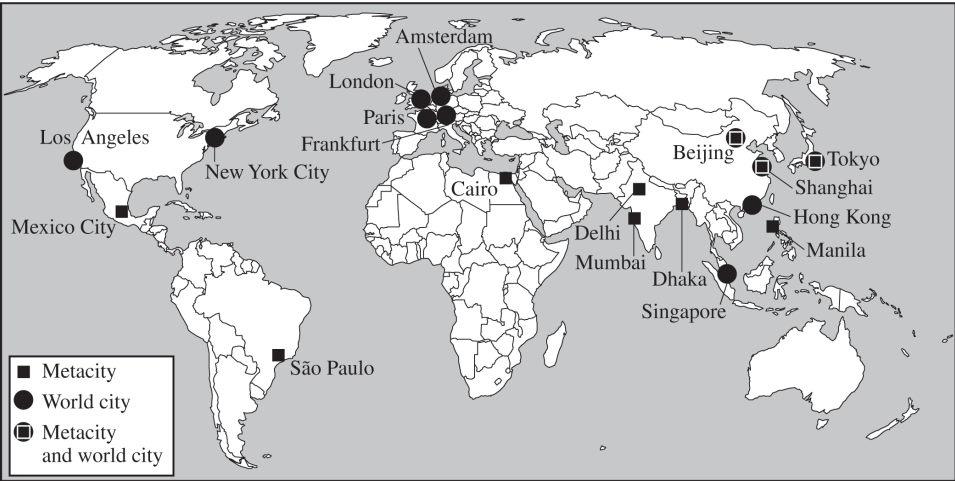
