Study these first. Each one shows the method for a question type used later.

■ Conic sections

Curves formed by slicing a cone. Standard equations:

- **circle:** $x^2 + y^2 = r^2$;
- **ellipse:** $\frac{x^2}{a^2} + \frac{y^2}{b^2} = 1$;
- **parabola:** $y = ax^2$;
- **hyperbola:** $\frac{x^2}{a^2} - \frac{y^2}{b^2} = 1$.

■ Example

$\frac{x^2}{9} + \frac{y^2}{4} = 1$ is an ellipse (sum of squared terms = 1).
