Objective

Build the skills to answer exam questions on **the normal distribution**.

You must be able to:

- describe the **normal distribution** 正态分布 as a symmetric, bell-shaped model with mean μ and standard deviation σ
- apply the **empirical rule** 经验法则 (68–95–99.7)
- calculate a **z-score** z 分数 and use the standard normal distribution

1 Worked examples

Study these first. Each one shows the method for a question type used later.

■ The normal distribution

Symmetric and bell-shaped, fully described by its **mean** μ (center) and **standard deviation** σ (spread).

■ The empirical rule

For a normal distribution, about **68%** of values lie within 1σ , **95%** within 2σ , and **99.7%** within 3σ of the mean.

■ The z-score

$$z = \frac{x - \mu}{\sigma}$$

gives how many standard deviations x is from the mean. With $\mu = 100$, $\sigma = 15$, $x = 130$: $z = 2$.
