1 Worked examples

Study these first. Each one shows the method for a question type used later.

- **Two kinds of error**
 - **Type I** — reject H_0 when it is actually **true** (a false alarm). Its probability is α .
 - **Type II** — fail to reject H_0 when it is actually **false** (a missed effect). Its probability is β .
- **Power**

Power = $1 - \beta$ — the probability of correctly detecting a real effect (rejecting a false H_0).
