**2.1** the mean is the average (sum divided by count); the median is the middle value when the data are in order.

**2.2**  $\frac{3+5+7+9+11}{5} = \frac{35}{5} = 7.$

**2.3** 7 (the middle value).

**2.4**  $11 - 3 = 8.$

**2.5** the mean –it is pulled toward the outlier, while the median (just the middle value) is barely affected.
