- a major military engagement among the measures by which the United States sought to contain communism

- both sides sought allies among new nations, many of which remained nonaligned

- the appropriate power of the executive branch in conducting foreign and military policy

(b)

- a nationalist movement could be read as self-determination or as communist expansion, and containment required a judgment

- as national self-determination or as communist expansion

- the first calls for support or neutrality while the second calls for containment, so the same facts produce opposite policies
