- It limits results to government domains.

2.2

- Authority, currency, bias, author, method, or date.

2.3

- A sentence includes many unnecessary words.
- Focused keywords are more likely to match studies or reports on the exact idea.

3.1

- For example: `social media sleep adolescents study site:edu`.
- It uses the main concepts rather than a long question.
- `site:edu` can help locate research from an identifiable education or research institution.
- The student must still evaluate the source before using it.

3.2

- The post is undated, so its currency cannot be checked.
- It sells an app, so it may have commercial bias.
- The author and evidence may not be clear.
- A named study or official report with a stated method would be stronger.
