2.1

- What is on screen, what is said, or the duration.

2.2

- $8 \times 15 = 120$ seconds, or two minutes.

2.3

- Spoken words take longer than silent reading suggests.
- The group can cut or revise the script before wasting recording time.

3.1

- The group may record unnecessary shots or miss an important explanation.
- The video may be too long or have no clear sequence when edited.

3.2

- Divide the two minutes into timed storyboard shots.
- This gives the video a clear sequence and keeps it within the limit.
- Write, source, and time the script aloud before filming.
- This checks accuracy and makes recording and editing more efficient.
