Listening has 4 parts with 10 questions each: 40 questions.

2. IELTS Academic

Academic is the test for study at degree level and above. General Training is for migration or study below degree level; Life Skills is a Pass/Fail visa test.

3. 250

Task 1 needs at least 150 words, Task 2 at least 250.

4. Listening; Speaking

Listening and Speaking are identical. Reading uses different texts, and Writing Task 1 is a figure in Academic but a letter in General Training.

5. Task 2

Task 2 is worth two thirds of the Writing mark, Task 1 one third. Give Task 2 its full 40 minutes.

6. letter

General Training Task 1 is a letter of at least 150 words. Academic Task 1 describes a figure, also at least 150 words.

7. True

Yes: a real examiner asks the questions in all three parts.

8. False

No. The questions, format, difficulty and scoring are identical. Only the test session and the Test Report Form differ, to satisfy UK visa administration.

9. 60

60 days, and the full test must have been IELTS on computer at a centre that offers the service. You may retake one skill, once, per full test.
