Work through these after trying the questions yourself.

11.6 It contracts and flattens (moves down).

11.7 It falls (it drops below the outside air pressure).

11.8 Any two of: expired air has less oxygen; more carbon dioxide; more water vapour.

11.9 Limewater; it turns cloudy (milky).

11.10 To bring in more oxygen and remove the extra carbon dioxide made by the working muscles.

11.11 As the chest **volume increases**, the air pressure inside the lungs **falls below** the outside air pressure. Air then flows **in**, from the higher outside pressure to the lower pressure in the lungs.
