- e.g. “The trip was **memorable**. We saw several **magnificent** buildings and the guide was genuinely **knowledgeable**. It was an **exhausting** day, but we came back **delighted**.”

- a translation does not tell you the **grammar** the word needs — preposition, what follows it, collocation
- it also gives no sense of **register** or situation, so the word may be technically right but wrong for the context
