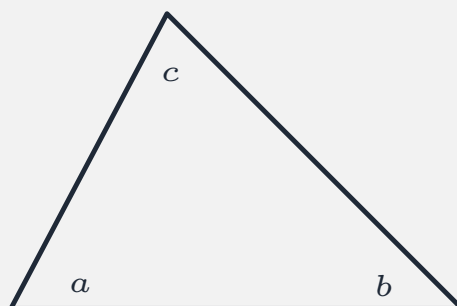

■ 1 Angles in a triangle

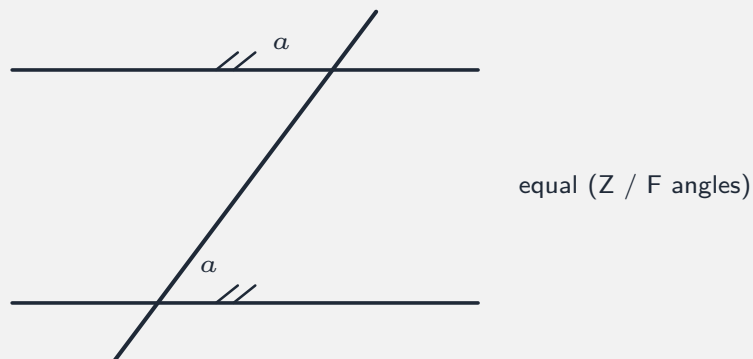
The three angles of a triangle add up to 180° :



$$a + b + c = 180^\circ$$

■ 2 Angles in parallel lines

When a line crosses two **parallel** 平行 lines, some angles are equal:



- **alternate** 内错角 (Z) angles are equal;
- **corresponding** 同位角 (F) angles are equal.

Watch out: the three angles of a **triangle** add to 180° . With parallel lines, **alternate** (Z) angles are equal and **corresponding** (F) angles are equal —look for the Z or F shape.
