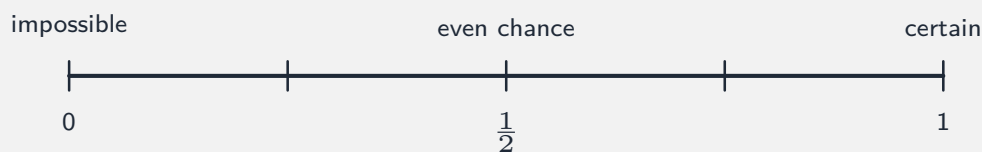
Recall

Probability 概率 measures how likely something is. It is a number from 0 (impossible) to 1 (certain).

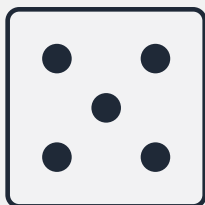
■ 1 The probability scale



A probability can be a **fraction** 分数, a decimal or a percentage.

■ 2 Working out a probability

$$P(\text{event}) = \frac{\text{number of ways it can happen}}{\text{total number of outcomes}}$$



$$\begin{aligned} P(\text{rolling a 3}) \\ &= \frac{1}{6} \end{aligned}$$

Watch out: a probability is always between **0** (impossible) and **1** (certain) —never more than 1 or negative. Work it out as $\frac{\text{ways it can happen}}{\text{total outcomes}}$.
